## NEW CONSTRUCTION CHECKLIST Requirements for Residential Building Permit Applications

1)	A completed Building Permit Application.  (City of Seneca Planning & Development, City Hall - 864-885-2726)
2)	City of Seneca Planning & Development, City Half - 864-883-2726)  — One paper and one digital set (thumb-drive) of Building Construction Documents.  They must include:  a) Complete Floor Plan with square footage, b) Footing and Foundation details c) Plumbing details and fixture layout, d) HVAC details, (Type and Tonnage or BTU's) e) Typical Wall Section, f) Truss Information, (Layout and Engineering) g) Electrical Layout and details. h) Any other details that are not typical. i) Hand drawn plans must be neat and done in a professional manner or they will not be accepted.
3)	One site Plan and <i>one digital copy</i> (thumb-drive) drawn to scale, showing location of proposed and existing structures and distances to lot lines.
4)	Certificate of Zoning Compliance/Flood Plain Check (City of Seneca Planning & Development, City Hall - 864-885-2726)
5)	911 Address Request and Verification Application (Oconee County 911 Addressing, 415 S Pine Street - 864-638-4250)
6)	Sewer Availability Letter (Seneca Light and Water Department, City Hall - 864-885-2723)
7)	Sewer/Septic Approval Letter Sewer (Oconee County Sewer Commission, 623 Return Church Road - 864-972-3900) -or- Septic System (SCDHEC - 864-638-4185)
8)	Approved Encroachment Permit from one of the following:  City of Seneca – 864-885-2750 (City Roads)  Oconee County – 864-886-1072 (County Roads)  SCDOT – 864-647-0798 (State Roads)
9)	<ul> <li>Before final inspection can be scheduled the following must occur:</li> <li>Contact the City of Seneca Business Office at 864-885-2700 to ensure all subcontractor business license payments have been made.</li> <li>Copies of termite, duct blast and door blower, energy code and insulation letters must be received by Planning Office.</li> <li>24-hour notice must be allowed for scheduling final inspections.</li> </ul>
